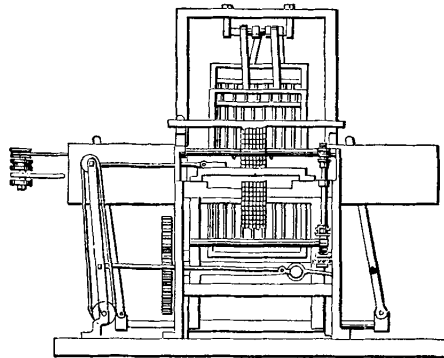


Piled-fab'ric Loom. One for weaving velvet, Brussels carpet, or plush.

In some cases, as in the example, two united piled fabrics are woven simultaneously and cut apart by a revolving knife oper-

ating in connection with a guard-finger in the loom to form velvet and similar goods. To vary the length of the pile, the guide-bars are set nearer or farther apart.
