And a surther Pramium of Fisteen DOLLARS to the Person who shall raise the second greatest Quantity: And a surther Pramium of Seven DOLLARS to the Person who shall raise the third greatest Quantity: The two last Pramiums to be understood to be under the same Restrictions as the first.

AND for encouraging a greater Perfection in Spinning, A Pramium of Seven DOLLARS is bereby offered to the Perfon, that shall this Year spin the greatest Quantity and since Thread for Linnen-Cloth with this Province; and a further Pramium of Three DOLLARS and a Half to the Per, I that shall this Year spin the next greatest Quantity and since Thread within this Province.

AND for encouraging a greater Perfection in Weaving, A Pramium of Seven DOLLARS is bereby offered to the Weaver, who shall this Year weave, within this Province, the hest and finest Piece of Linnen-Cloth; and a further Pramium of Three DOLLARS and a Half to the Weaver, who shall this Year weave, within this Province, the next hest and finest Piece of Linnen-Cloth.

THE Claims of the several Persons to the Four last Praemiums to be determined at the Manufastory-House in Boston, on the First Thursday in April 1753; and the Praemiums paid by the Treasurer to the Society for Encouraging Industry and Employing the Poor, for the Time being.

N. B. It is proposed to enlarge the Pramiums for the next Year.
