These shipping should put their name and address on, or in such package, and send on board with full particular and instructions by mail, express, stage, and dray. Ship my names and address plainly and neatly on each package.

Shipping Plates and Cards furnished when required for that purpose free of charge. Send prompt payment of goods that will immediately be delivered, otherwise by the most convenient and expeditious route.

Two-thirds of the market value will be advanced on the immediate receipt of the goods if desired. No returns will be made to shippers promptly after receipt of goods. Returns will be sent in a check by mail unless otherwise ordered.
