The Defense Intelligence Agency's Summer Internship Program provides current college students and recent graduates the opportunity to gain practical work experience through research, report writing, briefing development and delivery, policy writing, and intelligence analysis in order to gain valuable on-the-job experience while providing support to DIA's mission.

Interns are also exposed to the broader Intelligence Community through field trips, information sessions and panel discussions. Interns are appointed for a 10-12 week period from June through August 2017.

This program is open to rising seniors who will graduate no later than December 2017, post graduate students who are enrolled in the last year of their degree program, and recent graduates who have completed a qualifying bachelors or master's degree within the previous two years from an accredited U.S. institution. Must possess a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale at the time of application, and at the time of employment. All applicants must be a U.S. citizen at the time of application and are subject to a thorough background inquiry. All interns must be granted a security clearance and successfully pass a drug screening test prior to being made a final offer. The majority of the summer intern positions will be in the Washington D.C. metropolitan area though limited opportunities are available at other locations.

Due to the large number of applications received in response to internship opportunities, this vacancy announcement will be closed when a limited (depending on career field) number of applications are received, but no later than 23 September 2016.
