2. A one page printed essay about your decision to apply and/or attend The University of Arizona (why I chose Arizona) and what it means to be a student of the LGBTQ community. The essay should be about you, your intended field of study, your interests, concerns, expectations and goals. You need not restrict yourself to educational interests and are encouraged to be personal and write about things that are important to you. The essay should be up to two pages long, single spaced in 12 point type.
3. Unofficial transcripts.
